Songs and spoken chants with and without words, finger plays, bounces, live instrument demonstrations, movement exploration, scarves, parachutes, hoops and, for toddlers, playing simple percussion instruments such as egg shakers, jingle bells and drums, round out the MINI MUSIC experience. As your child progresses through the program, new and exciting musical discoveries will delight your child. Our classes also help parents and caregivers to understand the process of how children learn music. In a supportive, caring and PLAYFUL environment, our mission is to nurture the child's love of music and movement so that it will last a lifetime!

Our superb music faculty includes Rene Ebeling, Melanie Freaney, Diego Maugeri, Dawn Osenberg and Sandy Martin.

Children may arrive 15 minutes before class and stay 15 minutes after for instrument play, song requests and fellowship time for grown-ups!

Instrumental Music Classes

Meet the Violin

Children ages 3, 4 and 5 (older children admitted as space permits) will delight in this 4-week introduction to the violin, creatively taught by Sandy Martin. Children will learn the basics of violin playing (parts of the instrument, bowing and pizzicato techniques, how to hold the instrument, playing melodic and rhythmic patterns, simple songs, etc.) in a fun, non-pressured group class. Singing, chanting and movement are also part of the group classes. Children must be 3 years old by January 1, 2008. Violins will be provided for use in class during the introductory session.

The cost for "Meet the Violin", with a maximum of 8 children in a class is **\$50.00** per child for 4 classes. A parent or caregiver must attend with the child. If younger siblings must attend, please add \$20.00 per child. All classes are held in Room 202.

Meet the Guitar

Children ages 5, 6 and 7 will love this 4-week introductory class in guitar, taught by Diego Maugeri. Incorporating the philosophies of Music Learning Theory, Orff, Dalcroze and Kodaly, in a playful and informal setting, "Meet the Guitar" is designed to guide children through their first experience with the guitar. Without losing contact with the fundamental tonal and rhythmic acculturation via singing voice and movement activities, we will discover the "logic" of the strings, how many sounds are hidden there, and what our fingers can do about it. This is a precious opportunity to help our children to choose, with a better awareness, possibly their future instrument.

Guitars will be provided for use in class only, or you may bring your own. Class is limited to 6 children. Sorry, younger siblings are NOT permitted in this class.

Meet the Piano

Our piano class is designed to prepare children (ages 4, and 5) for piano lessons. The emphasis in this pre-piano class is to develop musicianship and keyboard skills in a relaxed, fun-filled environment. In this introductory class, children will begin to develop finger strength, coordination and dexterity; become familiar with the visual patterns on a keyboard through the use of glockenspiels, keyboards and a keyboard floor mat. Along with introductory keyboard skills, basic musicianship will be continuously expanded through movement and songs in various tonalities and meters. Teachers are Dawn Osenberg and Melanie Freaney. Children must be 4 years old by January 1, 2008. A parent/caregiver must attend with the child. Sorry, no siblings.

The cost is **\$50.00** per child for 4 classes. Classes are limited to 6 children. All classes meet in **Room 202** and will be held from **11:00 - 11:30 a.m.** on

Saturdays, January 19, January 26, February 2 and February 9.

1. \$15.00 of your total tuition is non-refundable. Balance of tuition is refundable if canceled by January 7, 2008. If canceled between January 8, 2008 and January 19, 2008, a \$25.00 credit will be issued toward the NEXT class session.

2. Payment in full is due upon registration for all classes. A completed registration form MUST accompany all payments. If viewing on our website, please print out your registration form and mail it in.
3. **CONFIRMATION POLICY (please note):**
Your first choice of class or classes is CONFIRMED unless we call you. No other confirmation calls will be made. Please make a note of your class day, time, starting date, building, room and teacher.
4. Make up days and times for all classes will depend on class enrollments. A list of make up classes will be posted beginning Week #3. All classes allow two (2) make ups per session. NO carryovers or refunds. Please DO NOT call our office to schedule a make up.
5. There is a \$5.00 per class charge for any non-registered sibling or guest. Adult visitors are always welcome at no charge.
6. Due to health and safety considerations, NO FOOD OR DRINK is permitted in the classrooms at any time. This includes adult beverages. NO cell phones or paging devices are permitted. Sick children should NOT be brought to class, including older or younger siblings. Siblings are not permitted to stay alone in halls or classrooms.
7. YIA/Mini Music reserves the right to cancel any class due to insufficient enrollment. If your class is canceled by YIA/Mini Music due to insufficient enrollment and placement in another class is impossible, your full tuition will be refunded.
8. We reserve the right to change teacher and room assignments without notice, if necessary.
