With a loving parent or caregiver, and a dedicated music educator to guide them, our classes "bathe" the children in music of many different styles and periods, tonalities and meters. Songs and spoken chants with and without words, finger plays, bounces, live instrument demonstrations, movement exploration, scarves, parachutes, hoops and, for toddlers, playing simple percussion instruments such as egg shakers, jingle bells and drums, round out the MINI MUSIC experience. As your child progresses through the program, new and exciting musical discoveries will delight your child. Our classes also help parents and caregivers to understand the process of how children learn music. In a supportive, caring and PLAYFUL environment, our mission is to nurture the child's love of music and movement so that it will last a lifetime!

Helpful hints for choosing a class and frequently-asked ???...

1. If you have more than one child of different ages, choose a class for the older child. Your younger child will benefit from the class. Here are a few examples:

For a 2-year-old and a 1-year-old, choose a Toddler 2 class.

For a 4-year-old, a 2-year-old and a baby, choose a YIA Family class, where all 3 children can come! (and bless your heart for coming!)

2. If your child has a birthday within the 8-week session, choose the older of the two possible classes. An example:

Your child will be 2 years old on November 1. Choose a Toddler 2 class!

3. "My 10-month-old baby has just started walking, but the other children are not." -

You may move into a Toddler 1 class. Talk with your teacher.

4. "I just got a job and I'm scheduled to work on the day of my class. HELP!"

You may switch classes. Call our office at 610-520-8838 for availability.

5. "My child doesn't seem to be paying attention and is cruising around the room. What should I do?"

First, don't worry. Studies show that your child is still absorbing what is being done in the class. As long as your child and the other children are safe, it's OK to cruise!

Mini Art

(for children ages 18 months to 35 months)

Your child will enjoy "getting messy" in our art classes designed with the young child in mind. Children will have the opportunity to explore various art media such as paint, clay and collage (smocks are provided!) and will take an up-close look at artwork of the great masters. All art materials used are non-toxic. *WEAR OLD CLOTHES!*

PLEASE NOTE AND READ CAREFULLY: A parent or caregiver must attend with the child. Classes are limited to nine (9) children and are held in the YOUNG-IN-ARTS CENTER. All classes are guided by Lauren Robertson, our art curriculum coordinator.

Meet the Violin

Children will delight in this 4-week introduction to the violin, creatively taught by Kerri Williams and Janet Pinkow. Children will learn the basics of violin playing (parts of the instrument, bowing and pizzicato techniques, how to hold the instrument, playing melodic and rhythmic patterns, simple songs, etc.) in a fun, non-pressured group class. Singing, chanting and movement are also part of the group classes. Children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2010. Violins will be provided for use in class during the introductory session. Class size is 3 - 6 children. One (1) make-up for "Meet the Violin" is permitted in a class listed below.

The cost of the 4-week series of classes is **\$65.00** per child. A parent or caregiver must attend with the child. Classes are held in the Fine Arts Center, church basement. Please use code number (V-1, etc.) on registration form.

Meet the Piano

Our piano class is designed to prepare children for piano lessons. The emphasis in this pre-piano class is on developing musicianship and keyboard skills in a relaxed, fun-filled environment. In this introductory class, short rote pieces will be introduced, and improvisational music-making encouraged, to spark an expressive connection with the piano. We will illustrate a story musically, experimenting with articulation, dynamics and tempo. Along with introductory skills, basic musicianship will be continuously expanded through movement and songs in various tonalities and meters.

Children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2010. A parent/caregiver must attend with the child. Classes are held in the Fine Arts Center, church basement. One (1) make-up is permitted in YIA Family class, if unable to attend available piano class. Please use code number (P-1, etc.) on registration form.

1. \$15.00 of your total tuition is non-refundable. Balance of tuition is refundable if cancelled by September 13, 2010. If cancelled between September 14, 2010 and September 24, 2010, a \$35.00 credit will be issued toward the WINTER 2011 session. NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER September 24, 2010.
2. Payment in full is due upon registration for all classes. A completed registration form MUST accompany all payments. If viewing on our website, please print out your registration form and mail it in.
3. **CONFIRMATION POLICY (please note):**

Your first choice of class or classes is CONFIRMED unless we call you.
No other confirmation calls will be made. Please make a note of your class day, time, starting date, room and teacher. We'll see you then!
4. Make up days and times for all classes will depend on class enrollments. A list of available make up classes will be available beginning Week #3. All 8-week classes allow two (2) make ups per session. NO carryovers or refunds. Please DO NOT call/email our office to schedule make ups.
5. There is a \$5.00 per class charge for any non-registered sibling, visitor, or guest attending with a registered child. Adult visitors are always welcome at no charge.
6. Due to health and safety considerations, NO FOOD OR DRINK is permitted in the classrooms at any time. This includes adult beverages. Please silence all cell phones and paging devices. Sick children should NOT be brought to class, including older or younger siblings. Siblings are not permitted to stay alone in halls or classrooms.
7. YIA/Mini Music reserves the right to cancel any class due to insufficient enrollment. If your class is canceled by YIA/Mini Music due to insufficient enrollment and placement in another class is impossible, your full tuition will be refunded.
8. We reserve the right to change teacher and room assignments without notice, if necessary.
